* Deadlines that fall on a Saturday, Sunday or University Holiday will be moved to the next business day.

Application Instructions

- 1. Attach a 250-500-word summary of the senior honors thesis project and an explanation of how the stipend will be used toward research or project expenses.
- 2. Return the form and summary to Mandeep Singh (ms2142@columbia.edu), Assistant Director of Academic Affairs.
- 3. Please obtain all requisite signatures before submitting application. *Electronic signatures are accepted, and approvals may also be obtained via email and appended to the application.
